Training Overview

The course is based in the IFRC
Guidelines for Livelihood
Programming and the LRC
Livelihoods Toolbox.
It has been designed to ensure a
combination of theory and
practice in order to
to improve interventions to
protect, restore, diversify, and
strengthen livelihoods.

Key training topics

- Understanding Livelihoods
 Recovering Livelihoods after
 Disasters and Conflicts.
- 2. Five types of Livelihoods Assistance for IFRC.
- 3. Conducting Livelihoods Assessment and Analysis.
- 4. Setting Effective Objectives and Targets.

Methodology

The course course combines theoretical content with practical exercises is conducted by an experienced tutor who provides individual feedback, facilitates discussion, and carries out a weekly evaluation through the six weeks of training.

Who should attend?

Volunteers and staff with experience in programming, but with limited or no experience in livelihoods, who are interested in expanding knowledge in this area. Applicants with some expertise in program design and implementation will be prioritized.

Time commitment


Participants must dedicate an average of 7 hours per week during the 6 weeks of training (about 40h for assigned reading and practical exercises).

Certificate

Upon successful completion of the course, participants will receive a certificate from the IFRC Livelihoods Resource Centre.

Cost

The course has a cost of 200 EUR per person, but is free of charge for selected participants as costs are covered by the Spanish Red Cross.



How to apply?

- Interested participants must submit application available on the LRC website here by 20th October 2025.
- Applications must include reference to a senior supervisor who endorses the participation of the candidate in the training.
- Due to the high number of applications, only selected candidates will receive a confirmation email.
